Guy's house is a treasure trove of antiques and he has several recommendations of where to pick up brilliant pieces. 'In London, Rose Uniacke is a great source, as is Tarquin Bilgen on Ebury Street. More and more, I am discovering lesser-known dealers via Instagram, and Ashbourne in Derbyshire is a rich hunting ground.'
