AESTHETIC MOVEMENT EBONISED OCCASIONAL TABLE

Ebonised oak in the Japanese style, the four table legs flare out to support a square tabletop with reeded rim. Elegant and elaborate scrolls decorate the top and base of the table legs whilst the central sections are turned. A shaped apron supports the tabletop whilst trefoil punching punctuates the stretchers

The present table is a fine example of Moyr's later penchant for the Aesthetic Movement, with his exposure to Christopher Dresser in London a particularly strong influence. Whilst the ebonised oak offers a thoroughly modern aesthetic and richness of colour, there is a notable lightness to the design, most profoundly felt in the delicate, pointed feet, and the presence of negative space in the punched trefoil details.
